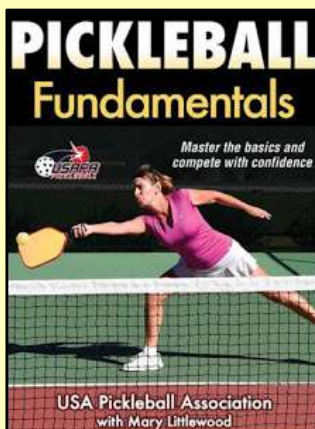

Question: Brian asks:

I am in need of a rule clarification. Under service rules, section 4, rules state that the service must be made

cross court and is a fault if served into the wrong court?

Also the interference rule states that a receiver nor his partner can interfere with the serve. But if the serve hits the receivers partner it is a point for the server?

Also it must be considered a fault as it was not served "cross court". Rule 7c states that a serve served into the wrong court is a fault and therefore is not a point. So how can a point be scored by the server serving a fault into the wrong court and hitting the receivers partner standing in his correct court?

When a serve is served into the wrong court, it means the ball has NOT bounced on the wrong side of the court, therefore it has NOT landed on the wrong court. When the server's ball hits the receivers partner, it is a point for the server because the ball has not bounced yet. The ball that has not bounced can still travel to the correct side of the court with a spin. Any time a ball hits a player before it bounces on the ground is a point for the opponents. It is also a point for the server if a served ball hits the receiver even if the receiver is standing outside the baseline if the ball has not bounced yet.
