I've been involved with the Comox Valley Pickleball Association (CVPA) for six years serving initially as a Board Member, then three terms as Vice President and now as President.

During that time the CVPA membership has grown from approximately 100 members to its current 510 members.

As with pickleball throughout the country this growth has its challenges which the CVPA has been able to navigate successfully with the building of several court facilities and strengthening the working relationships with all Municipalities.

I'm a competent pickleball player in my age group. Playing at the 4.5 level in both Canadian and U.S. National tournaments and having won a significant number of tournaments at the regional and local levels. Recently won Silver at the B.C. Provincial Championships at the 4.5 level.

Founder and head of the CVPA Training Academy. I personally teach between 12 - 15 hours per week and manage five coaches within the Academy. No coaches are paid, the Academy operates on a volunteer basis.
