Val joined the PC Board of Directors in Oct 2015 and served as President until January of 2018. In 2015, PC had less than 2000 members and by the time she left in 2018, we had several Provinces on board and over 10,000 members. She was involved in starting Pickleball Canada on the journey to becoming a National Sport Organization. She received an award from Pickleball Canada in August of 2021 for her leadership in developing the sport of pickleball in Canada.

Val is currently a Certified Referee and has been since 2017. She was Head Referee and ran the Ref desk for the Canadian Nationals in 2021 and for our annual Red Deer tournament in 2022.

Val is currently Treasurer for the Sun City Festival Pickleball Club in Arizona of over 1500 members.
