0.5 rating discussion

- 0.5 is causing a lot of issues and players are not seeing any value in the 0.5 difference.
- There is a struggle in having the 0.5 difference as there is a lack of sanction tournaments as a result of this difference.
- Group recommended that the policy should be changed to a 0.75 difference as it was felt that this will solve 80% of rating issues.
